Tax Cap Initiative likely to be a big winner; Sullivan leads mayoral candidates.

If the election were held today, over two out of three Anchorage voters (70%) report they would vote in favor of the “Repair Our Tax Cap” initiative.

Q. There may be an initiative called “Repair Our Tax Cap” on the ballot. It would reduce property taxes and return the Anchorage tax cap to how it used to be when all municipal income was included in the tax cap calculation. If the election were today, would you most likely vote for or against the “Repair Our Tax Cap” initiative?
