

New Alaska Poll:

“Most say ‘Senator Lisa Murkowski deserves re-election to the U.S. Senate.’”

A new AlaskaPoll® survey by the Dittman Research Corp. indicates that by more than 2:1, Alaskans agree that Senator Lisa Murkowski deserves re-election to the U.S. Senate.

Question: “Looking ahead to this year’s election for U.S. Senate, do you feel U.S. Senator Lisa Murkowski has been doing a good enough job for Alaska to deserve re-election, or should she be replaced?”

62% Deserves re-election
29% Should be replaced
10% Unsure

Registered Republicans report high support for Senator Murkowski (75% “re-elect”), and even nearly half (49%) of Democrats report she deserves to be re-elected. Non-partisan voters also report strong support for her re-election bid. Women and men report virtually identical perceptions in support of Senator Murkowski.
