



SARAH PALIN HOLDS LARGE LEAD IN ALASKA...

Republican Sarah Palin, who collected 51,334 votes in winning the Alaska Republican Primary election for Governor, now holds a 46% to 29% lead over Democrat Tony Knowles; who collected 36,815 votes in winning the Democrat Primary election.

In the strong “red state,” (President Bush received 61% of the Alaska vote in 2004 compared to John Kerry’s 36% -- 3% Ralph Nader/Other), Palin is strongly supported by Republican and Non-partisan voters.
